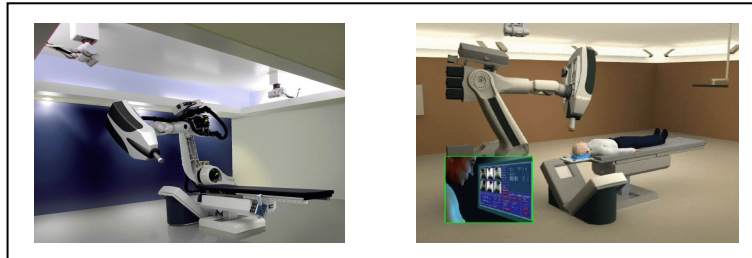

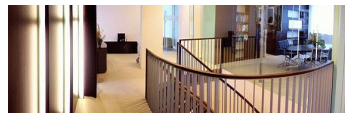


- **Painless treatments in comfortable out-patient facilities. No anaesthesia required**

CyberKnife® radiosurgery is a painless, non-invasive radiation treatment

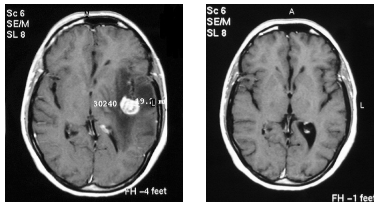
It uses multiple beams of high-energy radiation from multiple points outside the body to deliver a very high dose of radiation at the tumour or lesion inside the body, whilst sparing nearby normal tissue. It is so precise that radiation beams can be sculpted to small, complex-shaped tumours near critical structures, such as hearing and vision nerves.

This allows CyberKnife® to treat many lesions that may otherwise be considered inoperable or untreatable.

High accuracy

A lightweight radiation delivery system mounted on a multi-jointed robotic arm provides unparalleled access to tumours anywhere in the body, reaching areas that are untreatable with other radiosurgery systems and allowing more flexible delivery of radiation for optimum treatment.

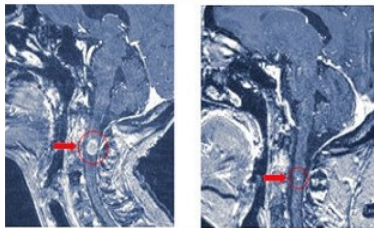
CyberKnife® uses an advanced image guidance system to locate a tumour throughout the treatment and correct for small patient movements, allowing radiation to be delivered without using a stereotactic frame.

Before treatment (left)

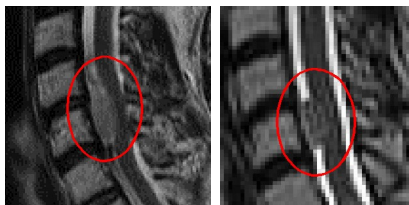
